

So much has happened at The Farm since our last newsletter. Of course the arrival of the Bridge surpasses any other news, as you know, without it we could do so little.

- The garden plot area has been tilled and staked and gardeners have already started to dig, plant, eat!
- Some manure has been delivered, thanks to Bill Hanlon.
- We have six 1000l container totes for water storage.
- Fruit plants and trees have been weeded and more rhubarb planted.
- Damaged trees have been cleared and mulched.
- Pathways are to be created and a sitting and picnic area is in planning stages.
- We have a applied for several grants for new fencing around the garden plot area, and more fruit trees.
